UC BOUND SENIORS...

All incoming students must take the UC AWPE on **Sat, May 13**. You should have received a letter directing you to your test location. ALL STUDENTS who will enter a UC as freshmen must demonstrate their command of the English language by fulfilling the Entry Level Writing Requirement. Students can meet this by scoring: 30 or better on the ACT, ELA; or Combined English/Writing, or 680 or better on the College Board SAT Reasoning Test, Writing, 3 or above on either AP Exam in English.
